Who is collecting your personal information?	Your personal information is being collected by the Australian Public Service Commission. The Commission's contact details are indigenous@apsc.gov.au .
Collection of your personal information	Your personal information was provided to the Commission by you when you nominated to participate in the Indigenous Mentoring Program.
Authority for the collection of personal information	Your information is collected for the purpose of the Public Service Commissioner's functions under the <i>Public Service Act 1999</i> , including fostering an APS workforce that reflects the diversity of the Australian population and strengthening the professionalism of the APS and facilitating continuous improvement in workforce management in the APS. The Indigenous Mentoring Program is one of a number of activities conducted by the Commission in support of these functions.
Why does the Commission collect your personal information?	The Commission collects your personal information for the purpose of facilitating the Indigenous Mentoring Program. Your personal information is used to allow the Commission to determine the mentoring partnership, and to contact you and provide you with relevant information about the Program.
What would happen if the Commission did not collect your personal information?	If the Commission did not collect your personal information, you would be unable to participate in the Indigenous Mentoring Program.
Who will the Commission disclose your personal information to?	Your personal information will be disclosed to your respective mentoring partner in order to commence your mentoring partnership.
Access to and correction of your personal information.	The Commission's privacy policy contains information about how you may access and seek correction of personal information about you that is held by the Commission.
Privacy complaints	The Commission's privacy policy contains information about how you may complain about a breach of the Australian Privacy Principles and how the Commission will deal with complaints.
Overseas disclosure of your personal information	It is not likely that your personal information will be disclosed to any overseas recipients.
