2	Terms and Conditions	Terms and conditions of the Program. Each participant will receive a questionnaire 2 weeks after completing registration to confirm acknowledgement of the terms and conditions.
3	Privacy and collection of personal information	Information on the requirements of privacy for the Program. Each participant will receive a questionnaire 2 weeks after completing registration to confirm acknowledgement of the privacy and collection of personal information document.
4	Confidentiality agreement	Information on the confidentiality requirements of the Program. Each participant will receive a questionnaire 2 weeks after completing registration to confirm acknowledgement of the confidentiality agreement.
5	Mentoring explained	An overview of Mentoring.
6	Tutorials (Video tutorial)	The Indigenous Mentoring Program platform is hosted by <i>The Art of Mentoring</i> . A tutorial (see tab in your profile) will guide you through navigating the software.
